 - 5. Parents, family, friends, or loved ones.
 - 6. Religious Creeds, Catechisms, manuals, or Disciplines.
- C. The Words that Jesus spoke will judge us on the last day. John 12:48-50

VI. JESUS' LAW IS EFFECTED AFTER HIS DEATH

- 3. Jesus brought forth eternal life to all that obey Him.
- B. Jesus' Law did not go into effect until <u>after</u> His death on the cross.

C. Jesus sends His disciples into the world to teach all things He has commanded.

- 1. Immediately after His death, Jesus probated His will.
- 2. Jesus authored for the first time, eternal life to all who obey Him.
- 3. At the probating of His will, Jesus stated that **all** who **believe**, **repent**, and are **baptized** will receive remission of sins, be saved, and will become one of His disciples.

- C. An immediate response is seen on the part of all who were converted in the New Testament.
- D. God has not changed His will concerning obedience to His word, since no additions or subtractions are to be made to His word.
- E. We obtain salvation today the same way it was obtained in the early New Testament times.
- F. Those who responded to the Gospel were added by the Lord to His church.
